## Niagara College Student Administrative Council Scholarship

**These scholarships are open to all domestic students who are enrolled full-time in a postsecondary diploma/degree or advanced study diploma/certificate program of education at Niagara College.**

### **NCSAC President Scholarship (2 @ \$3,500)**

This scholarship is for students who have proven leadership skills and have excelled academically, receiving a term average of at least 90% in the most recent academic term. To receive this scholarship you must write a brief letter describing yourself, academic achievements over the past year, outline a situation where you showed excellence in leadership, and describe why you feel you are the best candidate for this scholarship.

### **NCSAC Executive Vice President Scholarship (2 @ \$3,000)**

This scholarship is for students who excel academically, receiving a term average of at least 80% in the most recent academic term, and encourage teamwork among their peers. To receive this scholarship you must write a brief letter describing your future career aspirations, how you promote teamwork among your peers, and why you feel you are the most qualified candidate for this award.

### **NCSAC Health and Wellness Scholarship (2 @ \$1,300)**

The Health and Wellness scholarship rewards students who have shown leadership in many areas including environmental cleanup, and the promotion of student assistance programs and student food banks, just to name a few. Your outstanding and consistent concerns for the improvement of your college community could make you eligible for this scholarship. To receive this scholarship you must write a brief letter detailing volunteer work in which you have participated, and how you believe you have assisted others in improving their lives, and why you feel you are the most qualified candidate for this award.

### **NCSAC Community Events Scholarship (2 @ \$1,300)**

By tackling local challenges and working hard to make a difference, you're already demonstrating characteristics essential to leadership at all levels of your community.

To receive this scholarship you must show involvement in a volunteer organization and running or assisting in a community special event and activity, and why you feel you are the most qualified candidate for this award.

### **NCSAC Communications/Promotions Scholarship (2 @ \$1,300)**

To receive this scholarship you must write a brief letter stating your involvement in the promotion of an organization that works for the betterment of the community, a specific example of your work, and why you feel you are the best candidate for this award.

### **NCSAC Student Life Scholarship (2 @ \$1,300)**

An important part of your college experience is to discover your personal strengths and expand your interests. To receive this scholarship you must write a brief letter outlining your involvement at Niagara College, how it improved student life, and why you feel you are the best candidate for this award.
